



The Judge postponed the hearing on the motions for summary judgment in California Superior Court until August 7th @ 2:00. As with the Judge's previous postponement of the summary judgment hearing date, this should be viewed positively. The law and the facts heavily favor our position in this case, and the more time the Judge spends considering them, the more likely it is that we will prevail.

The National Grange's motion for summary judgment in the Federal Trademark case is still scheduled to be heard on 7/13/15. Additionally, on June 30, the Judge in the Federal Trademark case **denied** the McFarland Group's motion to consolidate the two trademark lawsuits involving the McFarland Group. The purpose of the motion was to delay the trial set in the National Grange's case for October.
